



House Bill 79 and other related acts



3301.41: Partnership for Continued Learning

- ***HB 79, Section 3301.41: Partnership for continued Learning. <http://www.pcl.ohio.gov>***
- ***HB 79, Section 5: Study the Operation of Community Schools by Partnership for Continued Learning***



3313.41 & 3314.051: Real Property Purchases between Community Schools and School Districts

- *School Districts, under certain circumstances, may now be required to dispose of real property for sale to community schools.*
- *Community Schools that acquired property in this manner must first offer it for sale to the district they purchased it from if they wish to dispose of it or close.*



3313.472: Policies on Parental Involvement

- *Each community school is required to adopt a policy of parental involvement.*
- *HB 79 requires the State Board of Education to adopt recommendations for the development of such policies.*



3314.536: Comprehensive School Safety Plans

- *(included in 3314.03 list of requirements)*
- *Primary change is that the Attorney General still requires a copy of the plan, but only requires a floor plan of the building; not a blueprint.*
- *Specifies that the floor plan is not a public record.*



3314.014 (A) (1) – Operator Provisions

• Definition of operator expanded from organization to include

- An individual
- A nonprofit organization



3314.015 (B)(1)(c)- Sponsor Provisions

- ***Reduction in the “cap” on the number of schools certain sponsors may sponsor***



3314.02 (E)(2)- Governing Authority

- *one year “time out” requirement between serving as a GA member and becoming affiliated with an Operator*



3314.025 – Governing Authority Compensation

- ***Maximum compensation per meeting and per month (\$125)***
- ***Maximum for dual GA membership***
- ***Source of funds differs with or without operators***



3314.026- *Rights of an Operator*

- ***GA terminates or non-renews an Operator's contract, Operator may appeal***
- ***< 12 months, State Board***
- ***=/> 12 months, Sponsor***
- ***Consideration: contractual compliance & academic progress***



3314.03 *Community School Contract Provisions*

- ***3314.03 (A)(4) sponsor's evaluation of schools is no longer linked to former expected gains***



3314.03 *Community School Contract Provisions, continued*

- **3314.03 (A)(11)(d) contract provisions now include:**
 - 2151.357: *Removes expungement of records and adds sealing of records.*
 - 3313.536; *School Safety Plan*
 - 3313.472; *regional fiscal agents*



3314.03 *Community School Contract Provisions, continued*

- **3314.03 (A)(11)(d) contract provisions continued:**

- 3319.313 – professional conduct investigations; information required
- 3319.314 – record storage
- 3319.315 – sections prevail over employment contracts



3314.03 *Community School Contract Provisions, continued*

- **3314.03 (A)(11)(g)** *deletes reporting requirements to LOEO*
- **3314.03 (A)(11)(h)** *requires display of U.S. and Ohio Mottos*



3314.22: E-Schools Computer Entitlement Waiver

The e-school must submit a copy of the waiver to the Office of Community Schools



3314.35: Ohio's Value-Added System

- *Replaces temporary language regarding Expected Gains for community schools*
- *Sets the criteria for closing poor performing community schools*
- *Applies to any school meeting the criteria after July 1, 2008*



3314.35, continued: Criteria Group 1

- *Offers any of grades 4 to 8, but not higher than 9*
- *In Academic Emergency for 3 consecutive years*
- *Made less than 1 year academic growth in reading and/or math under value-added for 2 of the 3 consecutive years*



3314.35, continued: Criteria Group 2

- *Offers any of grades 10 to 12*
- *In Academic Emergency for 3 consecutive years*
- *Made less than 2 years academic growth in reading and/or math under value-added for 2 of the 3 consecutive years*



3314.35, continued: Criteria Group 3

- *Does not offer any of grades 4 to 12*
- *In Academic Emergency for 4 consecutive years*



3314.35, continued: Criteria Based Outcome

- *The sponsor and governing authority must comply with closing procedures.*
- *The governing authority will not be able to enter into a contract with another sponsor.*



3314.35: Caveat for Grades 10 -12

ODE is tasked with determining whether using the value-added component will work for grades 10-12. If ODE determines that using the value-added component will not work for grades 10-12, criteria group 3 will be applied to high schools.



3314.36: Exclusion of Drop Out Prevention/Recovery Schools from School Closings

- *Drop out prevention/recovery schools may be granted a waiver by the department from school closure conditions.*
- *The department must act to approve or deny the waiver within 60 days of application.*
- *The department cannot grant a waiver to a community school that did not qualify for such a waiver when it initially began operations, unless the State Board of Education approves it.*



3314.36: Conditions under which a waiver may be granted

The school must:

- *Have a majority of students in a dropout prevention and recovery program.*
- *Serve students not younger than 16 and not older than 21.*
- *Enroll students who are either or both, one year behind their cohort age group or experience crises that interfere with their academic progress.*



3314.36: Waiver Conditions (cont.)

- *School must require students to pass state mandated graduation tests.*
- *Develop individual career plans for students that specifies their post graduation goals.*
- *Provide counseling and support for the plan developed during the student's high school experience.*
- *Prior to being granted the waiver, submit an instructional plan that demonstrates how the academic content standards will be taught and assessed*
